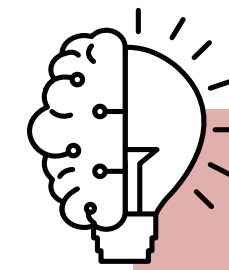
GAME OVER

PLAGIARISM IS: "LITERAL COPYING OF ALL OR PART OF ANOTHER'S WORK WITHOUT INDICATING THE SOURCE AND ITS AUTHOR" (TRUCHET, 2009).  
 APPROPRIATING SOMEONE'S IDEAS AND WORDS IS A CRIME (INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY CODE, 2012, ART. L 111-1). [THIS IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF RESPECTING QUOTES ;)]

IN CASE OF PLAGIARISM YOU EXPOSE YOURSELF TO DISCIPLINARY SANCTIONS FROM THE SCHOOL (FAILURE OF THE DISSERTATION, DISCIPLINARY COUNCIL, EXCLUSION, BAN ON TAKING EXAMS...)

## REASONS OF PLAGIARISM

- lack of knowledge what plagiarism is
- inadvertency (forgetting the quotation marks)
- lack of methodology
- by easiness (copy/paste)
- lack of skill in the citation rules

## HOW TO QUOTE

**In the text: abbreviated in brackets (Name, year, page cited if quoted in extenso).**

**At the end of the text in the bibliography : full citation according to APA norm**



## WHAT TO QUOTE

**Direct borrowing :**  
 verbatim (word for word) in quotation marks  
 reproduction of documents (photos, tables, videos, etc.)

**Indirect borrowing:**  
 reformulation of an idea or a text (paraphrase)  
 translations  
 adaptations
